REPORT PREPARATION

THE TITLE OF THE REPORT

(Arial, 14 pt, bold, single-spaced, capital letters, centered)

First Name & Last Name¹, First Name & Last Name²
(10 pt, single-spaced, centered)
Affiliation, full postal address, phone and fax numbers, e-mail address (for each author, if it is different)
(10 pt, single-spaced, italics, centered)

The abstract is up to 300 words (8 pt, single-spaced, full justify)

The submitted papers will be reviewed by the Program Committee and, if accepted, they will have been published in the special issue of the Conference Proceedings by the beginning of the conference.

An electronic version should be prepared using Microsoft Word 97/2007, XP for Windows, A4 format. The article must be 2-3 full pages. Please, use Arial font. The margins are as follows: left, right and top - 25 mm, bottom - 30 mm. The text must be typed in two columns 75 mm wide each, the interval between them being 10 mm, using single-line spacing.

See above the example of the paper title, authors' listing, affiliation, and addresses. The text must have the following headings: Introduction, Experimental, Results, Discussion, Conclusions, Acknowledgments and References. The headings must be typed using 10 pt, bold font. The indentation is 5 mm. Leave one blank line 10 pt before each heading.

Excess spacing between words and lines cannot be used.

The text of the report must be printed using 9 pt font, the abstract and references - 8 pt font. A list of references must be arranged in the following way:

References in the text are made using [].

Figures and tables can be included in the text and must not be wider than one column. Figure and table captions must be printed using 8 pt. Table captions are given above the table, figure captions - below. Figures must be grouped with captions.
